Overnight Campers

- Review Overnight Camper packing checklist (see pg. 7).
- **Check in** will start at 12:00pm in the lobby of the Rutherford Dorms (see map on pg. 10)
- Included meals at camps for overnight: Dinner 7/10; Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner 7/11 and 7/12; Breakfast 7/13. Please make sure your daughter eats lunch BEFORE check in on 7/10!
- **Key Deposit:** Please bring 50 dollars cash OR check for a key deposit. We will store this and it will be returned upon key return as long as there are no damages to the dorm
- **Check out** will start at 12pm on Thursday 7/13. At this time we will be wrapping up at the field and making our way back to the dorms. Check out will take place in the lobby of the Rutherford Dorms

- Included meals at camps for extended day: Dinner 7/10; Lunch and Dinner 7/11
 and 7/12
- **Drop off** for extended day campers will be at 1:00pm on 7/10. Extended day campers still need to check in at the front desk in the Rutherford Dorm lobby.
- Beyond the first day, campers should arrive ready to go at the Rutherford
 Dorms by 8:45am
- Pick up will be at 8:00pm at the turf or dorms every day other than check out day! Please make sure your daughter checks in with a staff member before. If someone other than a parent is picking up a camper, we need a signed permission form with the persons contact information on it
